FITA. Rules of Shooting will apply; including observation of FITA Dress Regulations. (Green / White / registered club colours only.) Please be prepared to show GNAS cards. Only members of GNAS or FITA are permitted to shoot at this tournament. GNAS members must supply their GNAS number.

Rules applied for this FITA round

- Sound-controlled timing with lights and count down timing, pairs of timers for both senior lanes and jnr lanes
- Four archers per target, two per detail, shooting in alternate details
- Practice round of about 45 minutes prior to the start of the competition
- At the two longest distances archers will shoot 6 arrows an end in 240 seconds (4 minutes) at a 122cm face
- At the two shorter distances archers will shoot 3 arrows an end in 120 seconds (2 minutes) at an 80cm face
- At the final distance we will shoot normal 80cm faces NOT the separate 4 faces per archer
- Arrow holes must be marked, FITA pass through/bouncer rules will apply.
- Under 18's wishing to claim FITA stars have to shoot the correct FITA cadet or FITA junior distance
